# Research project 1 summary

## Project Description

Proposed survey of known locations for the species and of adjacent similar habitat had to be deferred in 2018-19 due to the continuation of drought conditions across western New South Wales. Severe dry conditions will have prevented any germination of this annual sub-shrub occurring, making the chances of identification of plants in any survey extremely low.

## Outcomes or major success

Conduct the deferred survey in future years after above-average seasonal rainfall as this would give the best chance of finding plants.
