# Research project 1 summary

## Project Description

Based on findings from a University of Wollongong survey and germination trials in 2017 it was recommended that *P. sp. Olinda* be transferred to the site managed stream. A major change proposal was developed by the Saving our Species (SoS) Project Coordinator and approved by the SoS Technical Group. An expert panel is expected to be held in March or April 2020 to develop a site managed conservation strategy.

## Outcomes or major success

Major change proposal approved, species to be moved to site managed.

## Recommendation

Preparation for the expert panel to be held in March or April 2020.
